

## Acceptable Cannabinoid Chart

As the Ontario marketplace gets more competitive with a broad range of available legal products, consumers are increasingly choosing cannabis products (particularly dried flower and pre-rolls) with cannabinoid ranges +/- 2% or less. Licensed Producers are encouraged to continue to drive consistency among cannabinoid ranges to drive the demand of their products.
